OVERDRAFTS AND OVERDRAFT FEES

ATM/DEBIT CARD OPT-IN FORM

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways.

- 1. We have <u>standard overdraft practices</u> that come with your account.
- 2. We also offer one or more <u>overdraft protection plans</u>, such as a link to another checking account, a savings account or a home equity line of credit, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We <u>do</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We do not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means <u>we do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction. If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if Banterra Bank pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We may charge a fee of \$37.00 each time we pay an overdraft.
- There is <u>no limit</u> to the total fees that we can charge you for overdrawing your account.
- The maximum number of overdraft fees that we can assess is limited to six per day.
