BANTERRA BANK TO ASSIST AMERICAN RED CROSS DUE TO COVID-19 OUTBREAK; MOBILE BLOOD UNIT TO SET UP AT MULTIPLE BRANCHES

Marion, IL – In response to the nationwide blood shortage due to the COVID-19 outbreak, Banterra has responded to the national plea for assistance and has teamed up with the American Red Cross (ARC) to host the ARC Mobile Blood Unit at two banking center locations. The mobile blood unit will be at the following Banterra locations from 10 am – 2pm: March 24th - Carbondale (1500 West Main St.), March 27th - Marion (next to Home Depot at 3201 Banterra Drive) and March 30th - Cape Girardeau (1650 N. Kingshighway). Other locations will be added as needed.

"We heard the national plea for blood donors in yesterday's White House press conference and our team jumped on the phone to make this happen quickly," said Jeff May, president of Banterra Bank. "Working with American Red Cross is just one of the ways you will see Banterra offer support during this coronavirus health crisis."

"This truly is a critical time to offer blood donations. It is quick, easy and we have CDC-recommended health measures in place for everyone's safety."

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the American Red Cross has implemented additional measures to ensure the health and safety of all donors. This includes taking temperatures before giving, placing chairs outside the mobile unit and requiring social distancing. Donors can also wait in their cars if they feel more comfortable. To be eligible to give blood, you must be at least 110 pounds, be in good health and have a valid photo ID. Appointments can be made in advance at RedCrossBlood.org or by using the Red Cross Blood Donor App. Walk-ins are also welcome.
