Since 2017, more than 100 *Banterra* team members have assisted with the Southern Illinois flight.

Veterans Honor Flight covers airfare, bus fare, entry fees, food and supplies. In 2018, nearly 22,200 veterans have flown on an Honor Flight. Currently, there are 130 Honor Flight Hubs in 45 states.
